Amendment of Act on Stay of Foreigners

• Effective from 31st July 2019

Quotas on Employee Cards and Longterm business visas

Effective from 2nd September 2019

Government programs on economic migration

Effective from 2nd September 2019

Integration courses

Effective from 1st January 2021



First applications (filed at Embassy):

- Employee Card / Blue Card: CZK 5,000 (or equivalent)
- Business visa (stay over 90 days):
 CZK 5,000 (or equivalent)
- Long-term visa / Long-term residence permit: CZK 2,500

Following applications (filed at Immigration Authority in the CR):

- Applicants over 15 y: CZK 2,500
- Applicants under 15 y: CZK 1,000
- Paid in revenue stamps "kolek"
- Paid all when filing the application

Applicable for:

- Employee Card applicants
- Long-term business visa applicants
- Applications submitted at respective Embassies
- Determined by Government regulation it can be changed easily
- There are not any exemptions (only Governmental Programs)
- <u>List of countries</u> (39 Embassies and Consulates)

Announcement of change the employer- Employee Card:

- Free vacancy
- Notification form
- Employment contract
- Proof that former employment still persists or was terminated not later than 60 days ago
- (Diploma)
- Notification must be filed 30 days before the employment start
- Notification must be filed within 60 days after termination of previous job at the latest
- Immigration Authority will issue Confirmation on change of employer within 30 days.
- It does not extend the current employee card
- Not possible in the first 6 months from getting the first Employee card
- The above-mentioned is not required in case of exceptions => announcement about change of employer within 3 working days



- New definition of students for purposes of long-term residence permit
- Student of Erasmus Program can stay in other EU countries up to 1 year (but cannot work)
- Student holding a student residence permit/visa of other EU country can file application for Czech student residence permit at Immigration Authority in the CR
- No change of the term "study" in the Act on Employment = access to work
- Similar conditions for researches

Extra working visa

- For specific positions determined by Government regulation (No regulation issued yet)
- Valid up to 1 year, cannot be extended

Long-term residence permit—Employment search or Starting business

- For holders of student residence permit once the study is successfully completed and for holders of researcher residence permit
- Valid up to 9 months, cannot be extended

New permits / visas



Other news

- Address of stay is not printed on the biometric cards anymore – you can arrange an address stamp to your passport
- Certificate on Temporary Residence
 of EU citizen issued before 1/1/2010
 will expire 31/12/2019, other after 10
 years
- Labor market test for Employee Card or Blue Card can be 10 days only

Useful tips



Arrange your appointments online or via phone in advance



Check status of your application online



Announce change of address via mail – add request to provide appointment for stamping the address to your passport



File renewal application via registered mail – control that your surname is written on your postbox



Start renewal procedure as soon as possible, ie. 120 days before expiration
